






# NY TIMES BEST-SELLING AUTHOR SURPRISES 5TH GRADE STUDENTS

To kick off our Read-a-thon and create excitement for our students, Mrs. Puszka, our school librarian, worked on a project with the 5th graders and author Mr. Tony DiTerlizzi. Mr. DiTerlizzi is a New York Times best-selling author and illustrator, with popular titles such as *The Spiderwick Chronicles* and Caldecott-winner *The Spider & The Fly.* He has also worked on the art for popular fantasy games including Magic: The Gathering and Dungeons & Dragons.

During the 5th grade's library class, Mrs. Puszka read Mr. DiTerlizzi's chapter books *Kenny & the Dragon* and *Kenny & the Book of Beasts*. Absolutely captivated by his writing and drawings, the 5th graders persuaded their homeroom teacher to continue on with his stories by reading *The Spiderwick Chronicles*.

Mrs. Puszka and the class wrote letters and drew pictures to send to Mr. DiTerlizzi, highlighting their favorite scenes, asking questions, and even offering ideas. Much to the students' surprise, Mr. DiTerlizzi responded with a personalized video thanking the class, answering some of their questions and showcasing some drawings that they sent him. Thank you, Mr. DiTerlizzi!

This real-life connection to a children's author is a perfect way to announce our Read-A-Thon. Over the next two weeks, SRS will partner with the Read-A-Thon company to host a school-wide reading event. Students will challenge themselves to read as much as they can, log their hours, earn prizes, and compete with other homerooms to see which classroom spends the most amount of time reading! Our goal is to have families and friends encourage our students not only to develop stronger reading skills, but to also expose them to a wider world of books, fostering an ongoing love of reading.




Funds raised during the Read-A-Thon will help us renew our digital licenses and upkeep our school's technology resources used for reading and learning in our classrooms and at home.


